April 6, 2018 – University of Alabama Museum of Natural History

Join the **University of Alabama Museum of Natural History** and Legacy for a day of watershed education training. Learn how to use your local resources to enhance your watershed curriculum with hands-on learning activities. We will explore water, water resources, watersheds, Alabama biodiversity, and more!

❑ **Bio-Blitz at the Birmingham Botanical Gardens**

May 11, 2019 – Birmingham Botanical Gardens

Want to engage in a global citizen science project that is fun and easy to do? Join Legacy and educators from the **Birmingham Botanical Gardens** for this 1-Day workshop that will teach you how to plan and conduct a Bio-Blitz using the free [iNaturalist](#) smartphone app. The challenge is to find and document the MOST species as possible in the given time. Alabama native and Harvard University scientist E.O. Wilson described a Bio-Blitz as a “The engagement of citizen scientists in biodiversity exploration often starts with bioblitzes, which are treasure hunts designed to find and identify the largest number of species possible in one place.” You and your students could become actual citizen scientists!

❑ **A Sense of Scale! Using your Earth to Teach Earth Systems Science**

June 10-12, 2019 – McDowell Environmental Center

Taking place at the **Anniston Museum of Natural History** we will examine various habitats from around the world and the animal adaptations necessary for those habitats. Experience the **Bird of Prey Trail** and their specific habitat enclosures. We will also walk through the **Longleaf Botanical Gardens** and learn to identify native tree species.

❑ **Native & Invasive Plant Species of Alabama**

October 12, 2019 – Birmingham Botanical Gardens

Takes place at the beautiful **Birmingham Botanical Gardens**. We will discuss various Alabama plant species, how they are related to each other and their diverse habitats, and their ecological relationships with other Alabama species in both the built and natural environment. We will also cover the identification, management, and ecological impacts of Alabama's invasive plants.
